**Stayed in the Holy Land to protect and help
pilgrims (travellers).**

**Gave aid (help) and became known as
Hospitallers.**

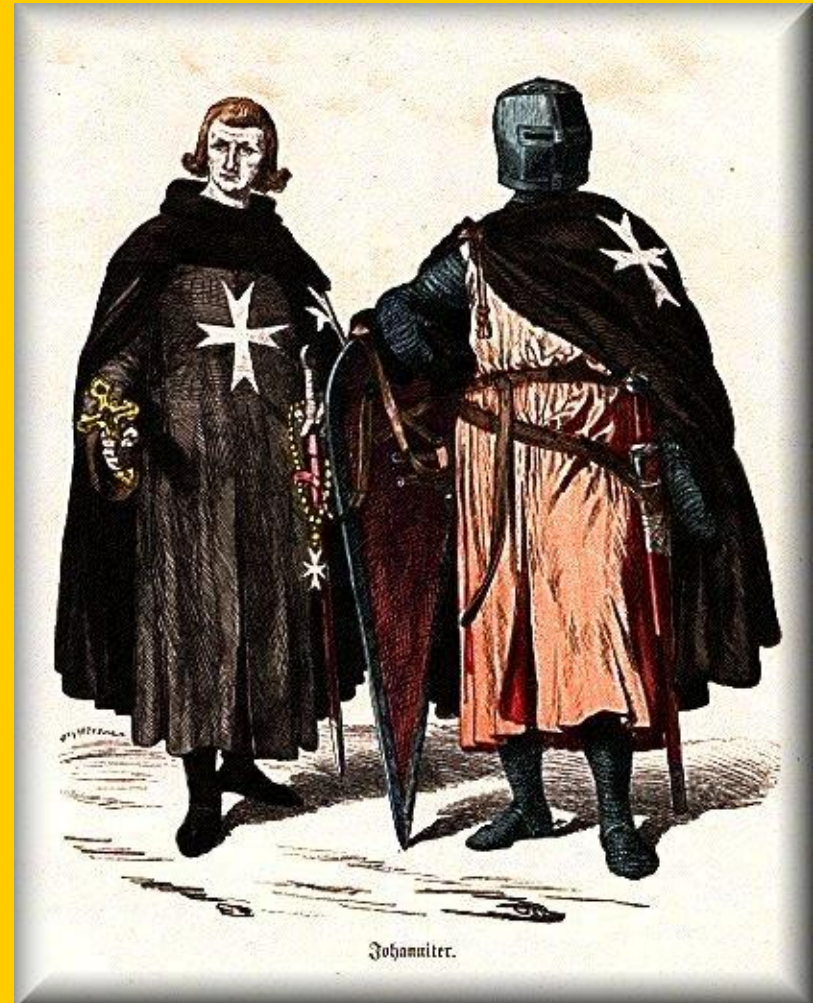

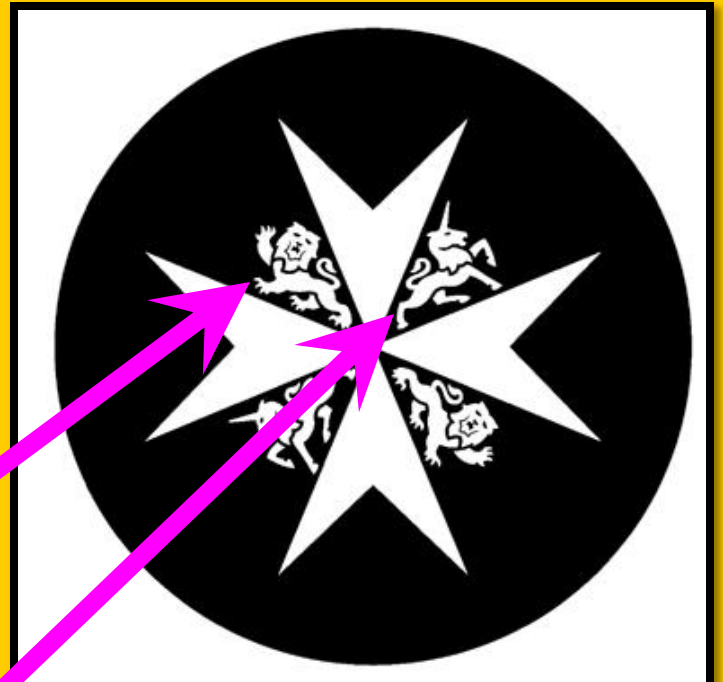
The order of St John began as an order of knights. It is an order of Chivalry.

Chivalry means –

- 1. The good values held by a group of knights.**
- 2. Politeness and consideration.**
- 3. Being noble.**



In 1880 Queen Victoria made the order a Royal Order and added unicorns and lions to the symbol. These came from the British coat of arms.
