History of The Order of St John

The origins of the Order of St John can be traced to an 11th century hospital - the Hospital of St John in Jerusalem. In 1113, the people who administered this hospital were formed into a religious Order. Soon after, they took on military duties and became known as Knights Hospitallers.

That Order, which still exists today, is now commonly known as the Order of Malta. It recruited members and owned property throughout Western Europe. The Order's principal property in Scotland was at Torphichen in West Lothian. Being Roman Catholic, the medieval Order ceased to function in England from April 1540, and in Scotland from 1565 when the Reformation took place in the reign of Mary Queen of Scots.

In the first half of the 19th century, a group of people set out to revive the Order of Malta in the United Kingdom, but ultimately formed themselves into a separate organisation which they called the 'Order of St John', which had no official recognition. In 1877, they founded the St John Ambulance Association, whose role was to provide training in first aid and similar activities. Ten years later, the St John Ambulance Brigade was created, as a uniformed body of trained volunteers to provide first aid cover to the public.

In 1882, as a further means of providing to those in need and recognising its origins, the Order opened a hospital in Jerusalem. This was to treat eye disease, prevalent in the Middle East.

In 1888, Queen Victoria made the Order a Royal Order of Chivalry, with the monarch as its Sovereign Head. Since then, the Grand Prior has always been a member of the Royal Family.

Today, the Order of St John functions throughout the United Kingdom, in many other Commonwealth countries, in the United States of America, and at the hospital in Jerusalem.



The Order in Scotland

In its early years, the Order provided training in first aid and related subjects in Scotland, as in other parts of the United Kingdom. However, the Scottish-based St Andrew's Ambulance Association was formed later and began similar activities, both in Scotland and in England.

In 1908, an agreement was reached that St Andrews would cease first aid training south of the border, and St John north of it. In the 1940s, some of its members felt that there was scope for the Order to undertake a variety of public services in Scotland, so in 1947, the Scottish Priory of the Order was established.

Over the years, the Priory of Scotland of the Order of St John responded to changes to some of these needs brought about by developments such as the creation and evolution of the National Health Service. This ranged from the building and managing of care homes, to the provision of vehicles to other charitable organisations.

In more recent times, under the banner St John Scotland, members of the Order alongside other volunteers continue to help communities in need through charitable works. Patient Transport services help those undergoing treatment for cancer or dialysis get to regular hospital appointments. St John Scotland is working to improve survival rate from cardiac arrest, by supporting communities to install Public Access Defibrillators, and offering free CPR training, while we also support a team of Community First Responders in Angus. St John Scotland also promotes community resilience through our work with Scottish Mountain Rescue teams and a Mountain Safety initiative in partnership with Mountaineering Scotland.

As well as work at home, St John Scotland has long supported the St John of Jerusalem Eye Hospital Group, as well as services run by our sister organisation, St John Malawi.

The Order of St John Today

Membership of the Order (as an Order of Chivalry) is conferred in recognition of work done in furthering its objects. Recommendations for admission to, or promotion in, the Order may be made by the chairs of the Area committees and by Grade I or II members.

Such recommendations are subject to scrutiny by the Priory Honours and Awards Committee, and are then submitted to Her Majesty the Queen for approval. New and promoted members are invested with their insignia at the Festival of St John, held annually in Scotland on or around the 24th of June (St John Baptist Day).

The Roll of Members of the Order in the Priory of Scotland is maintained in the headquarters. A member may request a copy of his or her recorded particulars at any time.



Grades of the Order

Under its Sovereign Head, Her Majesty The Queen, the Order has five grades:

- I** Bailiff & Dame Grand Cross, GCStJ
- II** Knight & Dame (of Justice or of Grace), KStJ & DStJ
- III** Commander, CStJ
- IV** Officer, OStJ
- V** Member, MStJ
- Clerical grades (eg. CHStJ) were withdrawn from use, however those holding them may wish to continue to use them

Foundation Dues and Oblations

Foundation Dues are payable upon admission to, or promotion in the Order and reflect the cost of insignia.

Members undertake to make an Annual Oblation to the Priory of Scotland in order to allow the Priory to maintain membership, organise the annual Festival, support the work of the Order worldwide as well as the charitable work of St John Scotland. The Priory Chapter sets minimum rates of oblations below but it is hoped that members will be pleased to make a greater contribution if their circumstances allow.

Order of St John Service Medal

All those who make a significant contribution to the charitable works of the Order of St John (whether or not they are a member) is entitled to apply for the Order's Service Medal.

The service medal is bestowed when an individual has completed at least 60 hours' service each year for ten years. Bars are added to the service medal to denote further years' service. This year, an ultra-long service medal has been introduced to recognise those who have contributed 50 years' service. Bars may be added to this medal up to 70 years' service.

Order of St John Award for Organ Donation



The Order of St John Award for Organ Donation is a UK-wide initiative in partnership with NHS Blood and Transplant (NHSBT).

Since 2013, the awards have been presented to the families of those who have lost loved ones within the past year, but whose decision to donate their organs helped saved the lives of others.

In Scotland, the awards are presented at a ceremony in Edinburgh during Organ Donation Week each year. The award itself is inscribed with the words "Add Life, Give Hope".

St John House, Edinburgh

The Chancery, or headquarters, of the Priory of Scotland is located at St John House, 21 St John Street, Edinburgh. This early eighteenth-century house lies off the Royal Mile a little below the site of St John's Cross in the Canongate. It was originally built for the Wemyss family and was generously gifted to the Order in 1971 by the late James Watt KStJ.

Chapter Room

On the first floor of St John House is the Chapter Room, which was relocated to its present location from the original Chancery building in Woodlands Terrace, Glasgow, when St John House was adopted as the Chancery in 1971.

The Chapter Room includes a Prior's chair and table, and chairs for the Chancellor and Preceptor of Torphichen. Stall plates depict the arms of living and deceased Knights and Dames of Justice. Mounted across three of the four walls, this displays a magnificent collection of heraldry of knights and dames of the Order in Scotland. Over the coming years, the collection will increase as further knights and dames are appointed.

In 2020, a book was published which documents the current Stall Plates on display in the Chapter Room. "Stall Plates of the Knights and Dames of the Priory of Scotland of the Order of St John", written by Director of Ceremonies Jim Bingham KStJ, is available for sale priced £9.95 online at bit.ly/stallplates or by contacting the staff team (details on the back page).



Library

The library of the Priory of Scotland is contained within St John House. It has a fascinating collection of books, documents, photographs and objects relating to the Order from its origins to the present day. Torphichen Preceptory

The first property in Scotland of the pre-Reformation Order was established at Torphichen in West Lothian. Acquired during the reign of David I, King of Scots (1124-1153), it became, and remained until the 16th century, the Order's administrative centre in Scotland. It was also a hospital and a place of worship.

The tower and transepts of the Preceptory building remain and the property is under the stewardship of Historic Environment Scotland.

With the help of volunteers organised by St John Scotland's West Lothian committee, the Preceptory is open to the public over weekends and bank holidays from 1st April to 30th September, between 1pm and 5pm. New volunteers are welcome and should contact volunteer@stjohnscotland.org.uk for more information.

Governance of the Order

The Order of St John is a separate body from its Priors and other establishments, and is registered with the Charity Commission of England and Wales. The Trustees are the Great Officers of the Order, the Priors of each Priory or their appointed representative, and the Order Hospitaller. Together, they form the Grand Council.

Grand Council meets once per year, and deals with matters beyond the responsibility of any one particular establishment, including Order-wide policy and strategy. The Great Officers and the Grand Council are supported by the Secretary-General, who heads a small secretariat in London. Each of the Priors, Commanderies and St John Associations has its own constitution. They are subject to the Charter, Statutes and Regulations of the Order, but within that they have a wide degree of autonomy.

In Grateful Memory

Amongst others lost to the Order over the past year were the following Grade I & II members.

Sir Malcolm Rognvald Inness of Edingight KCVO KStJ 25 May 1938 – 20 September 2020

Sir Malcolm Innes of Edingight (1938-2020) was the modernising Lord Lyon who, while maintaining the position of Scots heraldry as the purest and finest in the world, created a contemporary matrix envied by heraldically developing nations such as Canada, Finland and South Africa.

The cliché of “the Lyon’s den” was anathema to Sir Malcolm. While enforcing centuries-old heraldic law, he ensured that legislation met current standards, presiding as a judge of the realm in the only country where a court of heraldry and genealogy is fully integrated into the judicial system.

He appointed the first woman herald in the world in 1992, with heralds on duty at the opening of the first Scottish Parliament in 1999 providing gender balance before the term ever entered common parlance.

His reign (as the term of office of a Lyon is quaintly termed) oversaw the introduction of heraldic charges (the devices on shields) to cope with late 20th century needs such as computing and electronics, a period by which time he had long been familiar with heraldic use representing DNA and space travel.

Third son of Sir Thomas Innes of Learney, Lord Lyon 1945-1969, Malcolm Rognvald Innes grew up steeped in heraldry and armory. Learning and authorship saw his rapid rise through heraldic ranks, being appointed Lord Lyon in 1981, the 35th Lyon since Henry Greve (Greve) in 1399, a position with origins in the seannachies of Celtic kings.

A non-heraldic memory was that so little alcohol was ever served in his boyhood home near Torphins, Aberdeenshire, that the young Malcolm grew up believing that whisky was solely to counter wasp and bee stings.

With Charles Burnett KStJ, Sir Malcolm helped found the Heraldry Society of Scotland in 1977. He was also a founder and later president of the Scottish Genealogy Society, and an active past president of the Royal Celtic Society.

Sir Malcolm played an active role in affairs of the Order, sitting on Chapter, and in his role as Lyon, being Genealogist for the Order.

Sir Malcolm, 16th laird of Edingight in Banffshire, was appointed CVO in 1981, and promoted KCVO nine years later.

Sir John Shaw CBE KStJ FRSE
10 July 1932 – 5 April 2021

Sir John Shaw (1932-2021), Receiver-General of the Order 1992-2002, held a range of distinguished roles. He was first executive director of Scottish Financial Enterprise, and later governor of the Bank of Scotland. Passionate about education, he was professor of accountancy at Glasgow University.

He played a key role in the formation of the Scottish Higher Education Funding Council, bringing the funding of Scotland's universities directly under government auspices. In recognition of this, he held honorary degrees from several leading universities.

A lover of the arts, he was deputy chairman of the Edinburgh International Festival Society for a decade from 1990.

John Calman Shaw, known as Jack, qualified as a chartered accountant in 1954, completing National Service as an RAF pilot officer in fighter control in the then West Germany.

Sir John's talents came rapidly to the fore, and he worked on several high-profile audits including the acquisition of Crawford's by McVitie & Price to become United Biscuits. Early on, he made connections with higher education, exploring the creation of a centre for education and research in the application of computers to financial management.

A passionate and committed teacher, he helped found the Masters Degree in International Accounting and Financial Management at Glasgow University. He authored or co-authored three books on accountancy and many former students credit him as a valuable influence on their careers.

He became a non-executive director of Bank of Scotland in 1990 and deputy governor the following year, becoming governor in 1999, four years after he was knighted. At various times, he held numerous senior positions and directorships.

A lover of classical music, he often managed to combine teaching days at Glasgow University with performances by Scottish Opera, while holidays with his wife and family were arranged to coincide with music festivals in Austria or France.
